## Monday 23<sup>rd</sup>

**09:00-11:00 City tour (all participants) - Walking tour of the main attractions in the city centre.**

Meeting point: "Politeama Pratese" – main conference site

The historic centre of Prato is beautifully gathered within its medieval walls and it is a small chest with artistic and architectural treasures: **Piazza Santa Maria delle Carceri** overlooked by the **Basilica** and the **Castle of the Emperor** (the sole example in the Italian northern center of Swabian architecture of the time of Frederick II), **Via Pugliesi**, with its towers, the **Duomo**, that contains inside real treasures, among which the **Holy Girdle Chapel** frescoed by *Agnolo Gaddi*, where it is preserved Maria's precious relic, and the cycle of **frescoes by Filippo Lippi** in the **Cappella Maggiore**. The visit will end in **Piazza del Comune** overlooked by the **Palazzo Comunale** and the **Palazzo Pretorio**.

**11:00-12:00 City tour (all participants except MCE members) – Continuation of Walking tour**

The tour will continue with of the visit of the **San Domenico church** (dated 1281), the Renaissance cloister leads to the **Wall Painting Museum**, in which houses a collection of frescoes from other monuments, preparatory drawings, graffiti, dated XIV-XVII century. It preserves, among other, works by **Niccolò Gerini**, **Agnolo Gaddi**, **Paolo Uccello**.

From April 15<sup>th</sup> to September 15<sup>th</sup> the special event "Prato, precious echoes" **Donatello**, **Lippi** and other masterpieces of the Sacred can be visited at Museo dell'Opera del Duomo and the Museo Mural Painting. The visit will include also this event.

The visit will be lead by an English speaking expert guide and the registration fee includes all charges for the visit, including tickets for museums.

**12:00-14:00 Free time (al participant except MCE members)**

All conference participants (except MCE members) and accompanying persons can profit by this free time for shopping and to have their lunch.

## 14:00-17:30 Visit of Montalbano area (accompanying persons only)

Meeting point at 13:45 in „Piazza delle Carceri“ (see meeting point for bus trips in the previous map)



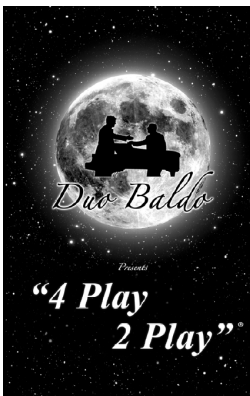
Departure by bus for Montalbano area: a splendid view of the Tuscan countryside on the outskirts of Prato, rolling hills of cypress trees, olive groves and vineyards that produce wines of high quality DOC and DOCG wines such as the Barco Reale Carmignano .

Guided tour of **Villa "Ambra"** commissioned by **Lorenzo il Magnifico** and built in 1484 by **Giuliano da Sangallo** in pure Renaissance style. Inside the important **Leone X hall** with frescoes of **Pontormo, Andrea del Sarto** and **Franciabigio**. Then the small Theatre, billiards room, and the apartments of "Francis I" and "Bianca Cappello".

Continuation of the visit to Carmignano where we visit the "**museum of Vine and Wine**," exploring the history and process of production of the famous "Carmignano," followed by a tasting of local wines, accompanied by biscuits from Prato.

On the way back, stop at the **church of San Michele**, where the famous painting "**The Annunciation**" by **Pontormo**.

## 20:00-23:00 Lord Mayor reception and concert (all participants)



This social event will take place in the main conference location at "Teatro Politeama Pratese". After a quick dinner the event foresees the performance of "duo baldo".

DUO BALDO is composed of the violinist Brad Repp and the pianist/actor Aldo Gentileschi. Their first significant performing opportunity came in April 2004 when, with the assistance of the "Fondazione Arpa" ([www.fondazionearpa.it](http://www.fondazionearpa.it)) in Pisa, they were invited to accompany tenor Andrea Bocelli in a concert for voice, violin and piano. Further engagements followed at such Italian venues as the "Teatrino di Vetriano" (Lucca), "Teatro del Lido" di Ostia (Rome) "Teatro Grande" (Brescia) and "Teatro Goldoni" (Livorno).

The duo has also been invited and re-invited to perform for many prestigious Italian music associations, including the Associazione Musicale Lucchese and Gli Amici del Teatro Alla Scala in Milan. In February of 2006, Duo Baldo won the first prize at the Concorso Nazionale di Corti Teatrali "In Breve..." (National Competition of Short Theatrical Works), held at the "Teatro Puccini" in Florence, Italy and also first place in the 2009 National Competition "Musicomicontest" in Prato, Italy.

They have also performed in America, Dubai (UAE), Luxembourg, France and were featured in the Maxiconcerto Pax Mundi (in remembrance of Pope Giovanni Paolo II), which was broadcasted throughout Italy on the national television network RAI2. Duo Baldo has appeared in concert on many occasions with the well-known Italian soprano Maria Luigia Borsi to critical acclaim, and most recently collaborated with the famed Italian pianist Bruno Canino in arranging and recording three fantasies from various operas by Giacomo Puccini. Meeting point at 08:45 in „Piazza delle Carceri“ (see meeting point for bus trips in the previous map)

**09:00am.** Departure by bus to the “**Chianti area**”, a region characterized by a succession of villages, vineyards and hills in a medieval atmosphere. The area is famous worldwide for the production of fine wines DOC and DOCG.

Visit of **Greve in Chianti**, with the particular triangular old square, flanked by buildings, porches and balconies that converge on the neo-classical facade of the **church of Santa Croce**. Time to buy wine at a butcher's Delicatessen-known internationally and at the famous wineries that represent the largest **Enoteca del Chianti**.

Continue to the **Castello di Verrazzano**, where **Giovanni da Verrazano**, explorer and navigator who discovered the bay of New York, borned in 1497.

Visit the gardens and cellars of the castle, followed by wine tasting and local products.

Return to Prato around 16:00.

**16:00 guided visit to the "DOLCELAB" (accompanying persons only)**

**20:30 – Visit to the Textile Museum and Gala dinner (all participants)**

Opened in 1975 in Tullio Buzzi Technical Institute, Prato Textile Museum commenced its cultural mission by providing a collection of items testifying the history of local textile production since the beginning of the 12th century for use in the training of new technicians in the textile design sector.

Prato Textile Museum is now a flourishing centre for the promotion of the local industrial district, a district which comprises around 8,000 companies and employs over 40,000 people.

Since May 2003 Prato Textile Museum has been definitively housed in the converted Campolmi textile mill, a symbol of the local textile manufacturing industry located in the centre of the city of Prato.

**Wednesday May 25<sup>th</sup>**

**09:00 – 13:00 Continuation of City tour (accompanying persons only)**

Meeting point: “Politeama Pratese” – main conference site

We offer an interesting guided tour to discover the historical and artistic heritage of the city, starting with the **Museum dell'Opera del Duomo**, where, in a path that winds its way through underground halls and chapels, there are masterpieces that are unique in Italy, including the famous marble bas-relief **Donatello's “dancing with angels”** (originally decorated the facade of the pulpit, where he now has been given a copy) and **Filippo Lippi's** altarpiece of the Funeral of St. Jerome.

The tour continues with a visit to the **Palazzo Datini**:



Desired by the Prato merchant **Francesco di Marco Datini**, was built in 1383 and represents a rare example of late fourteenth-century house painted outdoors. In 1390 in fact the most popular artists of the period, including **Niccolò di Pietro Gerini** and **Agnolo Gaddi**, were involved in the decoration of the courtyard and interior. The building was both a representative place

where they were hosted kings, nobles and illustrious personalities of both the workplace and business center.

The visit will proceed to **Piazza Santa Maria delle Carceri**, to visit the **prisons**, which can be accessed from the sacristy of the **Basilica**. The tour ends with a stop at the famous **biscuit shop "Mattei"**, guardian of the original recipe of 1858 of the famous **"cantucci"** of Prato. Here you can buy, in addition to the famous biscuits and other sweet specialties typical of the area.

**13:00 – 14:30 Lunch at “Teatro Politeama” (all participants)**

**14:30 – 18:00 “Walking in Florence”-Guided tour in the Florence City Center (all participants)**

Meeting point at 14:30 in „Piazza delle Carceri“ (see meeting point for bus trips in the previous [map](#))

Upon arrival, meeting with the guide to visit the old town. You will discover the art treasures that make this city one of the most visited in the world. The walking route starts from the **church of Santa Maria Novella**, whose facade is one of the finest examples of Renaissance Florence,

then continue to **Piazza Duomo**, the monumental and religious center with its **cathedral**, topped by the **dome by Brunelleschi**, the **Giotto's famous bell tower** and the **Baptistry**. A short distance the elegant **Piazza della Repubblica**, **Piazza della Signoria** and city lounge which overlooks the **Palazzo Vecchio**, where the **historic City Hall** is located. Visit of Palazzo Vecchio including the “**sala dei duecento**” e “**sala dei cinquecento**”. The tour ends with a pleasant walk to **Ponte Vecchio**.

Trip back to Prato at 18:30.
